

**PROCEEDINGS OF SPECIAL-CALLED MEETING
NATHHITOCHEs PARISH SCHOOL BOARD
HELD ON JUNE 4, 2013**

A special-called meeting of the Natchitoches Parish School Board was held on Tuesday, June 4, 2013 at 4:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the Natchitoches Parish School Board Office, 310 Royal Street, Natchitoches, Louisiana, and upon roll call, the following members and Derwood Duke, Secretary-Treasurer, were present: Cecil Walker, Ralph Wilson, J. Wilson, Harry Graham, Russell Danzy, Michael Hilton, Donna Masson, Carl Means, Thomas Melder and George Rhymes. Absent: Carroll Daniels.

The meeting was called to order by President Means, followed by an invocation by Mrs. Wilson and Pledge of Allegiance by Mr. Graham.

On motion of Mr. Rhymes, seconded by Mr. Danzy, and with unanimous consent, the Board convened into executive session to discuss litigation *Ruby Lee Calhoun, et al. v. Natchitoches Parish School Board*: Civil Action No. 80-1422 A on docket of United States District Court, Western District of Louisiana, Alexandria, Louisiana.

On motion of Mr. Danzy, seconded by Mrs. Masson, and unanimously carried, the Board adjourned out of executive session.

On motion of Mr. Wilson, seconded by Mr. Danzy, and unanimously carried the Board approved realignment of students in two phases in Natchitoches Parish as follows pending court approval.

PHASE I (2013-2014 School Year) Assign 7th and 8th grade students enrolled in Fairview Alpha Elementary Jr. High School to Lakeview High School Annex.

PHASE II (2014-2015 School Year) Assign 7th and 8th grade students enrolled East Natchitoches Elementary/Middle School, George L. Parks Elementary/Middle School and Vaughn Elementary/Middle School to Frankie Ray Jackson Technical Center.

On motion of Mr. Danzy, seconded by Mr. Wilson, the Board adjourned.
