**Pre-K**

- 1 red and blue rest mat with child's name on it
- 1 child sized blanket or towel
- 1 Backpack (mesh or clear)
- 1 large box Kleenex
- 1 large box wipes
- 1 bottle liquid hand soap
- 1 two inch three ring binder

Kindergarten

- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 boxes of baby wipes
- 1 box of gallon size ziplock bags
- 1 box of sandwich size ziplock bags
- 1 packages Lysol wipes
- 1 bottle of hand soap
- 1 bottle of sanitizer
- 2 package #2 pencils

- 2 black and white marble journals
- 4-2 pocket folders
- 1 binder
- 1 box of Ziploc bags
- 3 packs writing paper (wide rule)
- 1 bottle of hand soap/sanitizer
- 1 box baby wipes

2nd Grade

- 1-pkg of eraser tops
 - 2 Composition books black and white
 - 2 one subject notebooks
 - 2-pink erasers
 - 2 boxes of Kleenex
 - 1 roll of paper towels
 - 2- packs #2 yellow pencils
 - 1 pair round tip scissors
 - 1 pack fine tip dry erase markers (black)
 - * 4-2 pocket folders with prongs (plastic will last longer)
 - * 2-boxes crayons 24 count
 - * 2-glue sticks
 - * 1-supply box (such as a space maker)
- Items with * should be labeled with student's name

3rd Grade

- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 4 packages loose-leaf paper
- 4-2 pocket folders with prongs
- 1 pack glue sticks
- 2 five subject notebook
- 3 packages of 3x5" index cards
- 4 packages #2 pencils
- *NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- 2 two inch three ring binder
- 2 packs notebook dividers

4th Grade

- 2 boxes of Kleenex
 - 2 rolls paper towels
 - 4 packages loose-leaf paper
 - 4 packages #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
 - 6-2 pocket folders with prongs
 - 2 package of colored pencils
 - 2 glue sticks
 - 2 composition books, black & white
 - 3 packages of "3x5" index cards
 - 1 pair round tip scissors
 - 2 boxes crayons
 - 1 packs highlighters
 - 2 poster board (white)
 - 2 boxes eraser pencil tops

5th Grade

- 1-3 inch binder
- 1 package dividers
- 1 pocket folder of each color: red, orange, blue, yellow, green, purple (No Prongs)
- 4 packages of loose-leaf paper, wide ruled
- 4 packages of #2 pencils (12 in each package)
- * **NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**
- 2-12 count package colored pencils
- 1 pencil pouch with zipper
- 4 packages (3 X 5) index cards
- 1 package eraser caps
- 1 four package dry erase markers

6th Grade

- 2- packages of loose leaf paper
- 2 packages #2 pencils (mechanical or regular)
- 4 folders with pockets (with or without prongs)
- 1 box Kleenex
- 1 pack blue or black pens

**DRESS CODE WILL BE ENFORCED STARTING
THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL**

Shirts:

- Colors are: navy, gold or white (no logos)
- All shirts must be tucked in at all times
- Spirit shirts are only allowed on designated days
- Undershirts must be white

Bottoms:

- Colors are: navy and khaki
- Cargo shorts/pants are not allowed
- Shorts must come to the knee
- Students must come to school wearing a solid colored belt (no words or designs)

Shoes:

- No flip-flops
- No light up shoes
- Tucking pants in boots is not allowed.
- Socks white, black, navy or nude

Jackets:

- Colors are solid: navy, gold, white (no designs, words or logos allowed)

Hats:

- Students are not allowed to wear hats or hoods inside the building

Hair: Students' hair is a part of dress code. Students are only allowed to wear natural hair colors. This does not mean that a student does not have the right to change their hair color. It does mean that the new hair color must be a natural shade. (no pink, blue, red, green, orange or any other unnatural color)

Students may not come to school with distracting hair-cuts or designs.
